Our family are members of the Kuku Yalanji people who have lived in this area for tens of thousands of years.



What's unique about this tour is guests are experiencing part of our family's everyday lifestyle - nothing feels like it comes from a text book. It's about our deep connection with the land and being inside a living culture.

The Bloomfield Tour - Walk with us to see the Bloomfield Falls, after which Wujal Wujal is named. This is a place of great significance to us, and we'll share with you our knowledge of the area.

The Rainforest Walk - Be guided by us to some of the special places on our lands, part of the World Heritage area. We'll share our Yalanji culture, the history, bush tucker and bush medicine, with you.

Afterwards join us for tea and damper and a yarn-up and have the opportunity to buy art and crafts from the Yalanji people.

Walker Family Tours operates 7 days a week.

Guests can self drive from Cairns, Port Douglas, Mossman, Cape Tribulation, Cooktown, or fly/drive via the Bloomfield Airport or choose from a large range of tour operator itineraries that include our tours.
